

## PERSONAL AGRAR CARD OF ŽABLJAK

Mountain agriculture is present in this area, with 90% conventional production. Extensive livestock production is present in 90%, intensive farming in 70%, which presents organic farming and organic production of health-safe food.

**VILLAGE TYPE:** Scattered with less than 100 inhabitants. The average altitude of the village is 1400m. The most prevalent concentration of agriculture is in the villages of: Virak, Javorje, Pašina voda, Kovčica, Motički gaj, Novakovići, Junča do, Pitomine, Njegovuđa, Mala Crna Gora, Vrela, Gomile. The village have around 2000 inhabitants or 60% in 26 settlements.

**AGRICULTURAL HOUSEHOLDS** comprise 620 units, 460 are in livestock and 160 are in arable farming. The work force represent 606 farmers. Of the active population, 412, or 55%, is in agriculture. The average age of the agricultural holding is 57 years, and of the other employees in the family agricultural holding is 44 years.

**AGRICULTURAL COMPANIES:** Company HM DURMITOR. It is a mixed sheep cattle farm, with a maximum capacity of 500 ha of land, 1500 breeding sheep and 150 dairy cows.

**AGRICULTURAL COOPERATIVES:** There are 2 cooperatives in the Municipality with 30 subcontractors, namely Durmitor and Dobri do.
